Professional Practice

- 1987 – now *'Jane Sawyer Ceramics'*, independent studio practice based in Edinburgh, Scotland (1987 – 90), Fitzroy, Melbourne (1990 – 2004) and Kew, Melbourne (2004 – present). Studio practice involves mainly producing work for exhibition and private commissions but also some small-run commercial production.
- 1985-87 Traditional apprenticeship in Japanese methods of hand production and wood-firing in a contemporary ceramics studio, *Shussai-Gama*, Shimane, Japan. *Shussai-gama* is a unique studio producing large amounts of hand made ceramics for retail outlets and private sale. The studio was actively supported by the Mingei founding members in its early days and is now operated by second-generation potters. It is a community co-operative and recognised training facility. It fires a large 6-chamber climbing kiln once per month, one of the most prolific studios in Japan.
- 1982-85 Traineeship with Andrew Halford, Sydney, NSW (Awarded Australia Council grant). Halford trained with Shiga Shigeo, Les Blakeborough and Shimaoka Tatsuzo (Japanese Living National Treasure). His experience as a highly skilled and sensitive potter was an enriching introduction to becoming a ceramic artist after completing a teaching degree.
